Civil War "Cot" Quilts

During the time of the Civil War, quilts were very much in demand for the men on both sides of the War. These "cot" quilts were seven feet long and four and a half feet wide - a little longer and narrower than the throws we use today. Potholder quilts were made block by block, beginning with a simple six-inch nine patch pieced by hand. When enough blocks were made, the blocks were then stitched together. OLP Wednesday quilters made 84 potholder blocks at home – no sewing machines involved.

The completed cot quilt will be raffled off in the near future. We all hope you get a chance to see this unique work of needlework art.
